

Successful Completion of 38th BCS Orientation Program

A 12-days training program of the 93 newly appointed cadres (61 Civil, 32 E/M) from 38th BCS has been arranged by the PWDTA recently. It was initiated on the 16 February, 2021 at the Purta Bhaban conference room with a warm reception from the PWDTA officials. The course duration was 12 working days. The trainees were informed of the necessary information of the basic structure of PWD, its projects, what PWD does, its facilities and overall a total picture of PWD. Other than these, the cadres were given ideas about the rules of service, salary preparation and other financial facilities. Besides, basic ideas about estimation of electro-mechanical equipment, fire-fighting systems, CCTV systems and much other information about the modern electro-mechanical culture were delivered to the assistant engineers of E/M and the course for the assistant engineers of Civil were included the study of structural drawings, architectural drawings, geotechnical investigations etc. Moreover, all trainees were given ideas about the managerial, administrative and ministry level works. All the lectures were delivered by the respected senior officers of PWD and MoHPW. A very important lecture on anti-corruption rules and criminal laws was given by one of the Directors of Anti Corruption Commission (ACC). Our last session was conducted by the directional speech of Md. Shahid Ullah Khandaker, respected secretary of MoHPW, where functions of PWD, its problems, room for improvement and future scopes-all were discussed in a nutshell. At last, the certificates were given to the trainees.

Finally, a whole day field-visit was arranged for the trainees. The visit included the ongoing projects of NSI HQ and Suhrawardy Uddan and an excellent interior design of Osmani Auditorium. This visit is the example of the innovative structural designs and works done by PWD.
